

Bylaw #03/16
Village of Bittern Lake
Province of Alberta

Hereby known as "Mastercard Bylaw"

A bylaw of the Village of Bittern Lake, in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of establishing a borrowing bylaw with the Alberta Treasury Branch to allow for a maximum of \$5,000.00 in Mastercard Expenditures to be used for operating purposes only.

The previously mentioned borrowing amount will allow \$2,500.00 in Mastercard expenditures for the Chief Administrative Officer, and \$2,500.00 in Mastercard expenditures for the Public Works Foreman. Hereby removing previously listed Mastercard expenditures for the Assistant to the Public Works Foreman.

Section 256 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, S.A 2000 as of March 30, 2015 supports this authority.
