Bylaw # 04/09 Village of Bittern Lake Province of Alberta

A Bylaw of the Village of Bittern Lake in the Province of Alberta amends Bylaw # 05/06 which provides for the Licensing and Controlling of Dogs within the said Village or cited as the Dog Control Bylaw.

Referencing the Licensing Section numbered 4 and 5 of Bylaw # 05/06:

- 4. Every owner of a dog, <u>six (6) weeks of age or older</u> shall license such dog with the Village and pay to the Village a license fee in accordance with Schedule "A" of this bylaw.
- 5. Every owner of a dog, <u>six (6) weeks of age or older</u>, who take up residency within the Village shall, within fourteen (14) days license such dog with the Village and pay to the Village a license fee in accordance with Schedule "a" of this bylaw.

And whereas, the council of the Village of Bittern Lake deems it advisable to pass a bylaw to amend the current animal Control bylaw #05/06 to change the registration age for the licensing of dogs, from six (6) weeks to six (6) months.

Now therefore, the municipal council of the Village of Bittern Lake duly assembled enacts that Bylaw #05/06 be amended to add the following clauses pertaining to registration age of dogs;

- 4. Every owner of a dog, six (6) months of age or older shall license such dog with the Village and pay to the Village a license fee in accordance with Schedule "A" of this bylaw.
- 5. Every owner of a dog, six (6) months of age or older, who take up residency within the Village shall, within fourteen (14) days license such dog with the Village and pay to the Village a license fee in accordance with Schedule "a" of this bylaw.

This Bylaw shall take effect on the 14th day of December 2009.

Read a first time in Council this 14th day of December 2009.

Read a second and Third time in council and finally passed this 14th day of December 2009.
