

## The Village of Bittern Lake

Bylaw # 02/25 - 2025 Tax Bylaw

A Bylaw of the Village of Bittern Lake, in the Province of Alberta, to authorize the rates of taxation to be levied against assessable property within the Municipality for the 2025 tax year.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of the Village of Bittern Lake has prepared and adopted detailed estimates of the Municipal revenue and expenditures as required, at the Council meeting on April 16, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal expenditure and transfers set out in the budget for the Municipality of the Village of Bittern Lake for 2025 total \$\\$549,560.70\$ and

WHEREAS, the estimated Municipal revenues and transfers from all sources other than taxation is estimated as \$\\ \\$0.8,743.65\$ and the balance of \$\\ \\$240,817.05\$ (Pre ASFF) is to be raised by general municipal taxation; and

WHEREAS, the 2025 requisitions and adjustments are:

**WHEREAS**, The Council of the municipality of the Village of Bittern Lake is required each year to levy on the assessed value of all property, tax rates sufficient to meet the estimated expenditures and requisitions; and

WHEREAS, The Council is authorized to classify assessed property, and to establish different rates of taxation in respect to each class of property, subject to the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26, Revised statutes of Alberta, 2000 and amendments thereto; and

WHEREAS, the assessed value of all property in the Municipality of the Village of Bittern Lake as shown on the assessment roll is:
