



FIRE RESTRICTION

Effective September 24th, 2025, at 1200 hours, Camrose County is enacting a Fire Restriction

This Fire Restriction:

- 1) **Suspends** all existing FIRE PERMITS and prohibits the issuance of any new permits. All existing open burns must be extinguished.
- 2) **Prohibits** the discharge of FIRE WORKS.

The following are **PERMITTED** during this Fire Restriction:

- Burning barrels equipped with a metal mesh screen
- Safe wood campfires in approved fire pits on private lands and in campgrounds
- Portable fire pits and patio heaters fueled by natural gas or propane
- Cooking Appliances (Barbeques, Coleman Stoves) which are fueled by liquid propane or natural gas, including Charcoal (Briquette)
- Pellet style electric smokers
- Catalytic or Infrared style heaters

Off-Highway Vehicles can start wildfires – check frequently to ensure hotspots are free of debris, and make sure mufflers and spark arrestors are working properly.

Never leave <u>any</u> fire unattended. Soak it, stir it and soak it again until cool to the touch to ensure it is extinguished.

This Fire Restriction will remain in effect until further notice.
